Why: The City Council Joint Committee on Budget and Safety will consider proposals for police accountability.

Survivors of police crimes and torture, to testify and denounce Mayor's fake reforms (COPA), and demand CPAC

The Chicago Alliance Against Racist and Political Repression is calling upon the people, especially the survivors of police crimes and torture, to join us on Tuesday, October 4, 2016 to again demand that the Mayor and the City Council respect the people's demand for justice and that they enact the ordinance creating an all elected Civilian Police Accountability Council (CPAC).

There will be a press conference at 9am with police crime survivors and Alderman Carlos Ramirez-Rosa, who introduced the CPAC legislation into City Council on July 22, 2016. Survivors and family members will then testify, and demand CPAC be enacted, at the City Council Joint Committee on Budget and Safety hearing at 10am in room 201.

At every hearing held this past summer the people overwhelmingly rejected Mayor Emanuel's and all other so-called "reforms" that continue to leave the people powerless to stop police crimes. The people have demanded community control of the police.
